

# Alaska School Counselor Association Scholarship 2022

The Alaska School Counselor Association is pleased to present the Alaska School Counselor Association Scholarship Program. Full tuition and partial tuition waivers are being offered at the Alaska schools listed below for the post-secondary school year 2022-2023:

**Alaska Career College-** Five individual \$500 tuition waivers for Allied Health Programs (Medical Assisting, Phlebotomy Technician, Medical Coding and Billing, and Massage Therapy) & five \$1000 tuition waivers for Business Administration, Computer, Accounting and Human Resources Diploma and Degree Programs.

**AVTEC – Alaska’s Institute of Technology-** Three tuition waivers for any long-term program AVTEC offers - up to \$4,286 each. (Students will be responsible for Room & Board, books, supplies and any other fees.)

**University of Alaska Southeast-** Two \$2500.00 tuition waivers. \$1250.000 per semester. Non-renewable.

## Requirements

1. One nomination letter must be from school counselor that is a current member of AkSCA (counselors can nominate only 1 student for each)
2. Applicant must be a 2021-2022 graduate of an Alaska High School.
3. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time post-secondary student for the 2022-2023 school year.

## Scholarship applications MUST contain ALL five parts listed below:

1. The front cover must include:
  - *Applicant’s* full name, home community, email address, telephone number, and high school name
  - *Nominator’s* full name, school, address, telephone number and email
  - *School* to which the applicant has applied is identified (*Sample is attached below*)
2. Goal statement of the student’s PERSONAL and EDUCATIONAL goals (500 words or less).
3. Three letters of recommendation: *\*(letters must state recommender’s name and relation to student)*
  - One letter from the nominating **CURRENT** AkSCA member
  - One letter from someone **NOT** employed by the school district  
*Examples: Employment Supervisor, Clergy, Mentor, Family Friend, Legislator*
  - One letter from an employee of the school district  
*Examples: Principal, Teacher from Elementary or Secondary School, Cook, Coach*
4. An official transcript.
5. A list of extracurricular activities AND community / volunteer service.

## Selection will be based upon

- 25% Scholastic Performance
- 25% Goal Statement
- 25% Recommendations
- 25% Extra Curricular Activities and Service

Applications must be submitted by **March 18th, 2022 at 4pm Alaska time**. All documents should be saved as a single pdf and uploaded to <http://aksca.schoolcounselorawards.org> Applicants will need to create a login to upload their application.
