

## PIONEERS OF ALASKA KODIAK SCHOLARSHIP 2022

The Pioneers of Alaska, Kodiak will award three scholarships of \$1500 and one of \$1000.

### **Eligibility:**

High school seniors graduating from the Kodiak Island Borough School District and accepted to any accredited college, university or trade school in Alaska.

Kodiak residents already enrolled in postsecondary education at an Alaska college, university or trade school.

### **Application process:**

**Due on or before April 15, 2022.**

In a concise, one page essay, describe the following: 1) your background, 2) educational goals and time needed to achieve them, including your GPA, 3) commitment to and activities within your school and community, 4) your plans and dreams for the future, and 5) your financial need.

Applications will be scored on the basis of the completeness of your essay.

On another page, please list your full name, complete mailing address, phone number and email address. If possible, include your student ID number.

Also provide verification of enrollment or your letter of acceptance to a college or trade school.

The completed application must be returned to the counseling office at the high school or to Kodiak College, or submitted by email to Nancy Castro at Student Services, Kodiak College:

Scholarship recipients must agree that should their plans change, they must notify the Pioneers Scholarship Chair by August 1, 2022 so that the award can go to another candidate.
