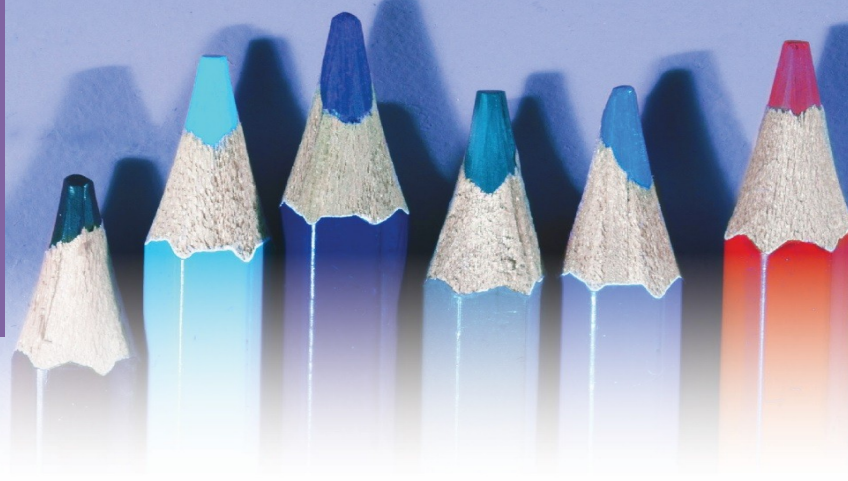

IMPORTANT DATES

AUGUST/SEPTEMBER

- Utilize AKCIS, FastWeb, College View to research colleges, scholarships
- Review graduation progress
- Decide on which colleges/universities/programs you plan to apply for and learn their requirements
- NCAA Eligibility Sign-up (collegiate athletes)-if you plan to play sports and didn't register junior year
- If planning to "graduate" early, turn in signed documents to counselor
- Kodiak College Scholarship Workshop #1-**Sept 26th**, 5:30-6:30pm at Kodiak College

OCTOBER

- Begin working on entrance/scholarship essays
- Scholarship preparation- Ask for recommendation letters (from school AND non-school personnel).
- Make a list of extracurricular activities, services, volunteerism, leadership roles, etc.
- Research Early Decision/Action admissions dates
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) opens **Oct 1** <https://fafsa.ed.gov/>
FAFSA is required for *most* college financial aid packages

- Please place student name on back of all photos submitted.
- Include whatever text and pictures you desire. Submit your own layout plans, your pre-made digital layout, or ask us to model your ad after a different ad.
- If you do not provide instructions for layout, we will choose a tasteful layout for you.
- If you would like your pictures returned to you, please include a self addressed stamped envelope.
- We reserve the right to lightly edit submissions per school guidelines.
- We will make every effort to use your layout and text as indicated. Due to our turn around time, proofs are not available, please clearly write/type all names.
- The most effective ads reflect a balance between word and pictures. Ad text can consist of personal messages, inspiring quotations, and/or passages from poetry.
