

Who Qualifies?

Does your child meet the following criteria?

- In the last year, traveled at least 20 miles from home for Migrant activity. Road, water & airway miles all considered.
- Traveled to participate in any of these activities:
 - Fishing – subsistence and/or commercial
 - Fish processing – cannery work
 - Logging
 - Agriculture (such as berry picking or farming)
- Activity lasted at least 7 nights and 8 days in a one year period. The dates do not need to be consecutive but must total 7 nights and 8 days.
- The Migrant activity is an economic necessity.

Program Enrollment

If you think you may qualify, contact the KIBSD Federal Programs Office. Annual surveys are sent home with students each school year. A Migrant Education Recruiter or staff member will contact you or the family for an interview. The information provided is submitted to and reviewed by the Alaska Department of Education, Migrant Education Office in Juneau. Once enrolled, students are eligible for three years but parents will be contacted yearly to update their information.

Specific Information and Requirements:
 Each requirement has additional guidelines that must be met to qualify. Eligibility is determined by the State of Alaska.
 1) **MIGRANT ACTIVITY** - Did the child travel to participate and/or look for Migrant activity? Migrant activity includes:
 Commercial: working on a boat or at a camp for commercial purposes (to sell your catch).
 Subsistence: gathering food (fish, crab, berries, etc.) for personal use by camp, gill fishing, gill netting, seining, etc.
 Fish Processing: cleaning, packing, etc. Harvesting: logging work. Agriculture: planting or processing crops and/or berries.
 2) **TRAVEL** - Child must have traveled a minimum of 20 miles one way. Road, water and/or air miles are counted.
 3) **TRIPS** - Only trips away from home that lasted a minimum of 7 night can be counted. Multiple trips can be combined but must total a minimum of 7 nights/8 days in a 12 month period within the last 3 years.
