



# CLOSE CONTACT EXPOSURE STUDENTS, STAFF & VISITORS

## COMMUNITY/SCHOOL EXPOSURE (Not Within Household)

To a person with Covid-19

Individuals are encouraged to follow the guidance of Public Health, however KIBSD is not requiring quarantine for close contacts as long as they have no symptoms. Masking will be strongly encouraged, but not required.

## HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE

To a person with Covid-19

### SYMPTOMATIC *Vaccinated / Non-Vaccinated*

Proof of Negative PCR/ Molecular Test, improved symptoms and fever-free for 24 hours required to return to school. Masking required until household member 10-day isolation period is complete.

Or

Stay home for 5 days after symptom onset. If symptoms are improved and fever-free for 24 hours, may return to school on day 6 with a mask until day 11.

### ASYMPTOMATIC *Vaccinated / Non-Vaccinated*

Required to test to continue to attend school in person. Make a plan with your school nurse or staff to use a combination of home tests and PCR/ Molecular tests at school. Masking required until household member 10-day isolation period is complete.

Or

Stay home for 5 days from exposure. If individual remains asymptomatic, may return to school on day 6 with a mask until day 11.

- Any PCR/ Molecular test conducted at school (parent permission)
- Any PCR/ Molecular test administered by a health care professional
- May use antigen home tests for asymptomatic monitoring

*\*Staff or students with a documented positive case of COVID-19 in the past 90 days do not need to test and can return to school with symptoms improved and fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication. May stay in school with minor symptoms.*
