SCHOOL PROTOCOLS FOR SYMPTOMS

PRE-COVID EXCLUSIONS

- Fever: **Oral temperature at or above 100.4 F. Individuals must be fever free** (without the use of fever-reducing medication) for at least 24 hours before they can return to school.
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Rash of unknown origin
- Any reportable infectious diseases

COVID EXCLUSIONS Major Symptoms

- Fever (>100.4F oral)
- Shortness of Breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Muscle/ Body aches
- New loss of taste/ smell
- Persistent cough

COVID FOLLOW-UP Minor Symptoms

- Congestion/Runny Nose
- Mild headache
- Mild fatigue
- Mild sore throat

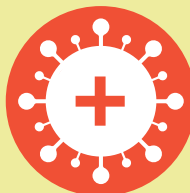
Test to Stay in School

WHAT TEST WILL WORK?

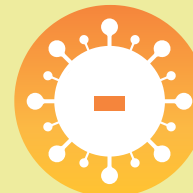
- Any PCR/ Molecular test conducted at school (parent permission)
- Any PCR/ Molecular test administered by a health care professional

*Staff or students with a documented positive case of COVID-19 in the past 90 days do not need to test and can return to school with symptoms improved and fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication. May stay in school with minor symptoms.

**If your healthcare provider determines your symptoms are from something else, you may return to school with a completed COVID-19 Symptom Care Plan from your provider as long as you have not had a fever in 24 hours without fever reducing medicine and your other symptoms are improving.



STUDENTS WHO TEST POSITIVE (OR WHO CHOOSE NOT TO TEST)



STUDENTS WHO TEST NEGATIVE

STAY HOME
With or Without Major Symptoms

If symptoms improved and fever free without medication for 24 hours, may return on day 6 with a mask until day 11.

RETURN TO SCHOOL
Without Major Symptoms

Return to school when symptoms are improved and fever free without medication for 24 hours.

STAY IN SCHOOL
With Minor Symptoms

Monitor Symptoms
