Boat Maintenance	26-28	May 30 – June 2	KHS Certificate	6 left
Description: Experience basic maintenance and repair on 2-stroke outboards, bilge pumps, motors, electrical components, and a variety of safety and communication equipment. Students will be on a boat in the harbor for 1 – 2 days.				
Construction for the Trades	91	May 30 - June 16	1 / 2 Cr. KHS Certificate	4 left
Description: Finish the interior of a tiny house. Experience interior construction. Skills include project management, installing electrical wiring, floor coverings, sheetrock, kitchen and bathroom plumbing, design/installation of cabinets and fixtures, and trim carpentry. Students with Welding experience may opt to engage in building a base for the frame. Upon completion of the 3-week intensive, workplace learning or summer job placement, may be available.				
Early Childhood Education	91	May 30 - June 16	1 / 2 Cr. & 1 Certification	3 left
Description: Experience proficiency and confidence in teaching children from birth up to age eight (third grade), using high-quality instructional practices, in a variety of settings. Optional: Earn an industry-recognized Babysitting Certification or hours toward a Child Development Associate Certificate. Upon completion of the 3-week intensive, possibilities for work-based learning or summer.				
Electrical AC/DC	91	May 30 - June 16	1 / 2 Cr. & 1 Certification	5 left
Description: Experience interactive, hands-on learning using a simulated online program. Learn skills in Motor Control, AC/DC Electrical Systems, Relay Control, Electrical Fabrication, Motor Braking, Sensors, and Motor Troubleshooting. Earn an endorsed national certification at the end of the 3-week intensive.				
Health Intensive	Reduced to 40	June 5 – June 9	2 Certifications	4 left
Description: Earn TWO certifications that may be used to jumpstart several career pathways, including Fire Sciences and Emergency Services. Certifications include Blood-borne Pathogen certification and Emergency Trauma Technician (ETT) certification.				
Medical Billing & Coding	91	May 30 - June 16	1 / 2 Cr. & State Exam	5 left
Description: This is a new opportunity for seniors and graduating seniors who are 18 or will soon be 18. Learn how to convert medical diagnoses, procedures, labs, supplies, and equipment into procedure codes. Create insurance claims for payment and submission to insurance companies. Students, age 18 may sit for examination and earn a state certification as a Medical Coding Specialist. Upon completion of the 3-week intensive, possibilities for workplace learning or summer job placement may be available.
