<ul> <li>Understand factors that protect against or contribute to sexual risk behaviors.</li> <li>Learn the signs of intimate partner violence and the importance of safely getting help for self and others.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Describe healthy and safe relationship characteristics.</li> <li>Summarize the differences between healthy and unhealthy relationships.</li> <li>Demonstrate strategies to manage conflict in respectful and nonviolent ways.</li> <li>Communicate how to safely get help for self or others if involved in an unhealthy relationship.</li> <li>Explain the importance of respecting individual differences in sexuality, including being an ally.</li> </ul>

Students will understand safe sex practices.		
Knowledge Expectation	Skill Expectation	
<ul> <li>Understand abstinence as an effective method of protection from STIs and unintended pregnancy.</li> <li>Understand methods to prevent unintended pregnancy and STIs, including HIV (e.g., internal and external condoms, dental dams), and their effectiveness, and risks.</li> <li>Understand signs of pregnancy, the importance or pre- and post-natal care (FASD, NAS, SIDS)</li> <li>Learn the myths and facts surrounding pregnancy and birth control.</li> <li>Understand types of emergency contraception including abortion.*</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Summarize the benefit of abstinence as the most effective method of protection from STIs and unintended pregnancy.</li> <li>Summarize ways to prevent STIs and unintended pregnancy.</li> <li>Explain where to find health services for obtaining tests for STIs and HIV.</li> <li>Discuss the risk factors and warning signs of STIs.</li> <li>Recognize early signs of pregnancy and importance of pre- and post-natal care.</li> <li>Identify the benefits of talking with parents and other trusted adults about sexual health.</li> <li>Demonstrate an understanding of the local agencies that can assists with sexual health, safe sex practices, contraception, etc.</li> </ul>
