Understand healthy ways to express affection, friendship, empathy, and sympathy. Understand the difference between healthy and unhealthy relationships. Understand the relationship between risky behaviors and unhealthy relationships. Recognize warning signs that lead to unhealth relationships. Explain characteristics of someone who has see respect and self-control. Analyze characteristics of healthy relationship (e.g. family, peers, dating)

Explain why individuals have the right to refuse any sexual contact or activity. Explain that rape and sexual assault are illegal and should be reported to a trusted adult. Explain why it is everyone's responsibility to verify that all sexual contact is consensual. Understand the consequences of sexting and cyberbullying.	 Identify the signs of dating violence.
